

NIGHT LIGHTS TO CATALYZE CAPACITY BUILDING

Power Utilities | Nov 28, 2023

India's electricity consumption is growing sharply, rising ~9.5% in the first 8 months of this fiscal and ~15% in the past 5 months alone. FY24 peak demand of ~241GW to date is ~12% higher than in FY23. Non-solar evening spikes in demand have led to a peak deficit of as much as 3.5%-3.8% on some days in Aug-Sep. Expect a ramp-up in capacity building across power utilities.
